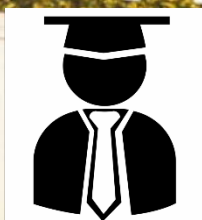

2022/2023 STUDENT BURSARY APPLICATION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

SAIAT has pleasure in announcing that application for the 2022/2023 Student Bursary Award is now open.

1. Overview

The **South African Institute of Architectural Technologists NPC** (SAIAT) is a passionate self-governing institute whose vision is to stimulate the expression of design and the application of technology in architecture.

In line with our objective of "*assisting in the facilitation of the study of and research in architecture as well as in the promotion and recognition of excellence in the practice of architecture*", The SAIAT Student Bursary programme seeks to financially support undergraduate students in obtaining qualifications in architecture.

2. Definitions

ALS - SACAP Accredited Architectural Learning Site which is the institution where the applicant is studying architecture

3. Eligibility

The bursary is open to academically qualifying young people who fulfil ALL of the following:

- The applicant is in 2022 a second and/or third year student studying architecture / architectural technology full-time at an ALS;
- The applicant is a citizen of the Republic of South Africa.
- The applicant has passed all the courses for which they have registered for the study period already completed.
- The applicant is a student member of the Imagine Architecture Community (sign up [here](#))
- Students in arrears with their ALS fees are eligible to apply.

Please note that the Selection Panel can contact any applicant for an interview - this will not be an indication of a successful application



4. Requirements

All applications must be accompanied by the following documents - all in PDF format. Failure to upload these documents will result in the application being null and void.

- Certified copy of ID / Passport
- Certified academic records since enrolment with ALS
- Proof of Income (if required) from parents/guardians
- Affidavit stating that applicant has not been rewarded/going to be rewarded in terms of any other bursary, including NSFAS
- Financial statement (not older than 14 days) from ALS
- Letter from HoD confirming applicant's enrolment for 2023

5. Application procedure

- Applications can only be done by completing the online application form here at <https://www.saiat.org.za/education-fund>
- Only one application per applicant - if more than one is received, the first application will be considered, and the rest discarded.
- No late applications will be accepted - all applications must be submitted online no later than 12:00 on Friday 18 November 2022 (the system will not allow any late applications).

6. Award

- The successful applicant will an amount not exceeding R50 000.00 that will be paid directly to the ALS to cover tuition and possible official accommodation fees.
- The name of the successful applicant will be published on <https://www.saiat.org.za/education-fund> at 12:00 on Friday 02 December 2022.
- The decision of the Selection Panel will be final - no correspondence regarding the award of the bursary will be entertained.
- If a bursary is awarded to a student based on information supplied, and evidence is received later that the information supplied was not true, the student will have to pay back all monies received, plus interest at the ruling bank rate, within 30 days after notification. A case of fraud will be opened with the SAPS against such student and parents/guardians.

7. Obligations

The recipient of the 2022/2023 bursary shall represent SAIAT as a Student Ambassador for 2023. based on the Terms of Reference of the SAIAT Student Initiative, the student's specific roles and responsibilities as ambassador shall include the following:

- Represent SAIAT in a sufficient manner in interactions with students, various beneficiaries/stakeholders, and the public;
- Compliment SAIAT in facilitating the exchange of information as well as knowledge-sharing among students training in architecture on various experiences and issues affecting the study of architecture and preparation for professional practice;
- Participate actively in all sessions and activities related to the SAIAT Student Initiative;
- Be aware of the SAIAT Student Initiative's Terms of Reference;
- Keep their ALS Head of Department/Faculty informed of SAIAT's activities regarding the Student Initiative (<https://saiat.architecture.co.za/student-initiative>);
- Submit quarterly reports to the SAIAT National Committee of Members in writing.

8. Timeline

- 18 November 2022 - Application submission deadline (12:00)
- 21-25 November 2022 - Adjudication of applications
- 28-30 November 2022 - Interview if required with shortlisted applications
- 02 December 2022 - Announcement of award (12:00)
